


## [FCC Online: Retirement of PDFs](#)

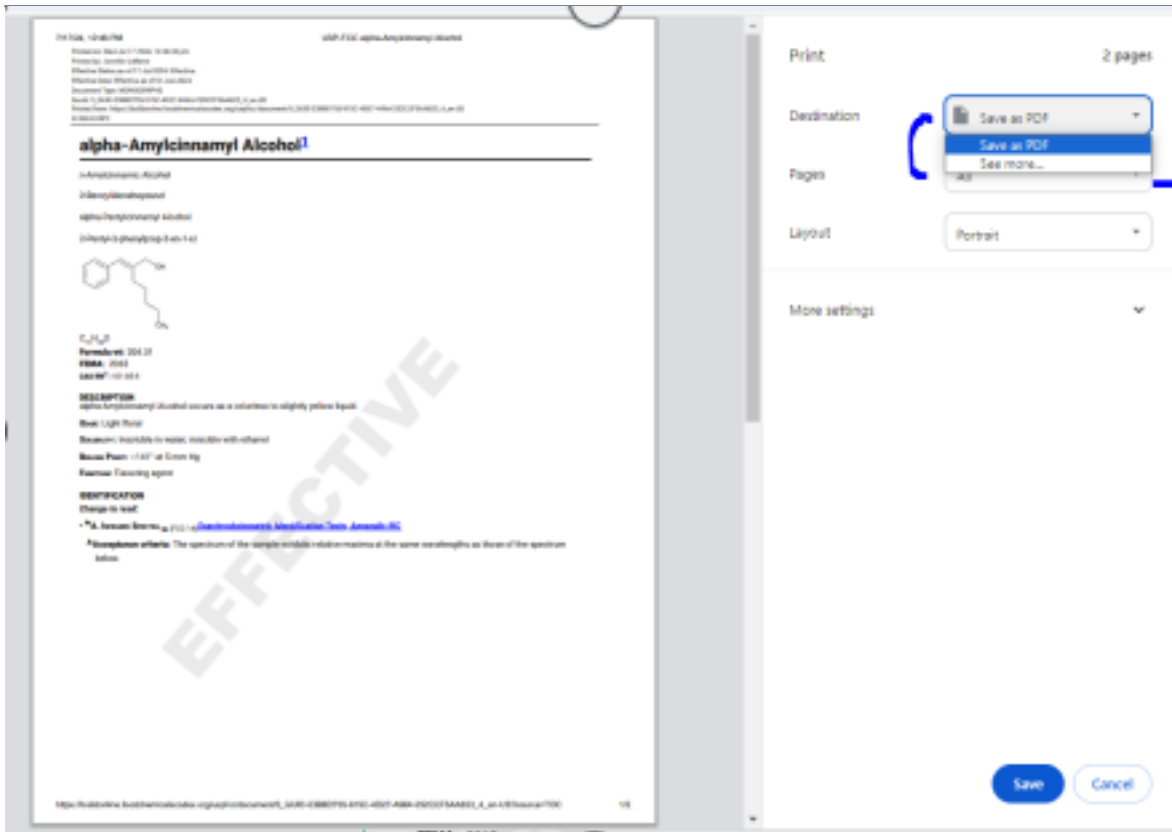

USP will retire the PDF feature in FCC Online effective December 6, 2024. On this date, users will no longer see the PDF icon in the document toolbar marked below.
